# Exam Pattern & Syllabus for English Stenographer(Group-B)

The candidate applying for English Stenographer (Grade-B) has to appear in Paper-I, Paper-II. The candidate successfully qualify (Paper-I and II) will be called for the Paper-III (which is the typing test). Syllabus for Hooghly District Court is given below:

Subject	Questions covering spelling, correct use of words, correctness of sentences, use of common phrases, synonyms & antonyms and punctuation.

Duration of paper	1 hour & 6 minutes (66 minutes)
Total Marks	400 Marks
Subject	English dictation lasting for 6 minutes followed by transcription of notes in candidate's own handwriting for an hour.

Type of question	It is a typing test in English language
Typing Speed Required	not less than 30 words per minute

Questions for Typing Test	The candidate will be provided with English manuscript.
